5. Evidence and Date of TFI School Walk-through completed by a trained external coach/staff (external to the school/site)			
6. Evidence of a current Tier 1 Action Plan			
7. Evidence of Tier 1 Meeting Agendas and Meeting Minutes			
For SILVER RECOGNITION, all of the above, PLUS:
